RESPONDING TO INCIDENTS, DISCLOSURES AND SUSPICIONS OF CHILD ABUSE

Everyone within our sport plays a role in safeguarding Children and Young People. In the event of an incident, disclosure, complaint, allegation or suspicion of child abuse, follow these important steps – further information can be found in Australian Cricket’s Policy for Safeguarding Children and Young People.

STEP 1

CHILD REPORTS, YOU OBSERVE, SUSPECT OR ARE INFORMED OF AN INCIDENT OF CHILD ABUSE

STEP 2

IF A CHILD IS IN IMMEDIATE DANGER, RISK OF HARM OR FOR EMERGENCIES CONTACT POLICE AND AMBULANCE ON TRIPLE-0

REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE POLICE (DETAILS BELOW) AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

REPORT TO THE NOMINATED CHILD SAFETY OFFICER OR MEMBER PROTECTION INFORMATION OFFICER WITHIN YOUR ASSOCIATION OR CLUB AND ENSURE YOUR STATE/TERRITORY ASSOCIATION IS ADVISED

STEP 3

THE DEPARTMENT AND POLICE WILL PROVIDE FURTHER ADVICE ON NEXT STEPS
